

Resolution 10/2017

CREDIT HOURS: USE OR EQUIVALENCE

The Coordinating Committee of the Graduate Program in Chemistry at the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul, in a meeting held on July 26, 2017, in the use of its attributions,

DETERMINES

Art. 1 - That the use or equivalence of credits hours for courses of study taken in Graduate Programs in Chemistry or related areas with a CAPES 4 or higher grade will be evaluated by the Graduate Committee of the Graduate Program in Chemistry, following the criteria:

§1° - For Master, a maximum of 4 (four) credit hours may be used or considered equivalent.

§2° - For Doctorate, a maximum of 12 (twelve) credits can be used or considered equivalent.

§3° - Equivalence is only related to Mandatory courses of study.

Art. 2 - The applicant must send to the Graduate Program secretary the Formular with the respective historical presenting the final grade, syllabus, and summary of the requested course of study.

§1° - In the case of a request for progress or equivalence of credits referring to more than one discipline, the documentation requested above must be delivered separately for each request.

§2° - For courses of study taken at PPGQ/UFRGS, the request for use must be made by email (ppgq_iq@ufrgs.br) indicating only the name of the courses of study to be used.

Art. 3 - Situations other than those specified in this resolution will be analyzed by the Graduate Committee.

Art. 4 - This resolution revokes Resolution 07/2014.



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
